What's a Watershed?

All the land that water flows over, or under, on its way to a creek, wetland, Bay or Ocean. Everything on the land is part of that particular watershed. This includes buildings, people, plants, wildlife, etc. - and pollution! Marin has many different watersheds.

What's In Our Watershed?

- There are over 100 rare, threatened, or endangered species that live in Marin's watersheds - e.g. Northern Spotted Owl, Red-legged Frog, and Tiburon Lily.
- About 100 creeks in Marin contain endangered or threatened salmon, steelhead, or a combination of both. Stay out of these creeks from January through May when fish are laying eggs and/or hatching. They're often invisible to the naked eye.
- There are over 13,000 storm drains in Marin. In addition to carrying rain, these drains also carry pollutants from streets directly to local creeks, bays, and the ocean.
- Only rain should go down a storm drain! Soap, lawn clippings, paint, wash water, pesticides, used motor oil, cigarette butts, etc. should NOT! Learn more at www.mcstopp.org
